DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

The works comprised the complete refurbishment of The Cut in Lambeth.

This included paving works to footways, lay-bys and raised tables, PC paving and Yorkstone paving plus new granite kerbworks. Drainage, surfacing works, soft landscaping, street lighting, signage and street furniture also formed part of the works.

Marshall's Conservation paving was used within the footways on both sides, with Yorkstone paving and granite setts laid to the raised table locations along the road. Granite setts were also laid within the new loading and car parking bays.

The refurbishment of The Cut is the first major project to go through Transport for London's Area Based Schemes Step process, from initial design to construction.
