DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Construction of new children's playground

Civils completed the development of a replacement play area for youngsters in Newham, East London. The old playground was demolished to make way for a site for travellers controversially relocated from an area needed for the new Olympic Park.

The £350,000 project involved the re-profiling of ground levels and removal of contaminated soil, the planting of an orchard of fruit trees, creation of grass areas for wildlife, safety surfacing and installing play equipment and furniture.

More than 1,300 tonnes of fill material and 246 tonnes of topsoil were used in the work for the London Development Agency. This included special Playtop recycled safety matting, playground equipment (slides, rope bridges, swings etc).

The area also required a new picnic area with tables and seating, accesses for children and maintenance vehicles along with safety perimeter fencing and gates.

The construction required two reinforced concrete retaining walls with integral benches to support the split level appearance of the finished playground.
