### **FM CONWAY'S NEW ASPHALT RECYCLING PLANT UNDER CONSTRUCTION**

Kent-based highways, maintenance and civil engineering company FM Conway is putting the finished touches to what will become one of the UK's most modern asphalt recycling plants.

When complete, the £7m plant at the recently acquired Erith site, will handle up to 400,000 tonnes a year and be well placed to service the company's term maintenance contracts in London and the South East.

The 2,000 sq ft, two-storey offices, which will house the sales and orders and production departments, are currently being built, and the major components that will make up the plant itself are now on site.

Michael Conway, managing director of FM Conway, commented: "This new plant will set us apart from the competition and the investment will certainly allow the business to develop further.

"We are a responsible business and so recycling and the environment are at the core of what we do. It is envisaged that the plant will take recycled aggregates from other sites and use aggregates from projects we are working on."

FM Conway is also currently investigating the practicalities of using the wharf-based site to take ship-borne aggregates.
