Anyone fortunate enough to have met Michael will know that he took true enjoyment in engaging with people and until recently, was well-known for his visits to sites and depots where he would speak to our frontline workers to ensure that he was hearing feedback first-hand. Michael was also the founder of the London Construction Academy, formed to provide opportunities for people not in employment, education or training. He was passionate
